In spring 2020, the globalised world will be severely affected by the pandemic spread of the coronavirus. Adult education and vocational training institutions in particular will be affected by closures and limited direct learning opportunities.

Digitalisation is playing an increasingly important role in all areas of education. However, adult education has a special responsibility and importance as it reaches citizens outside educational institutions in non-formal or even informal learning contexts.

DEAL will develop and pilot an approach based on a long-term partnership of educational partners who have worked either in digital literacy and digital education projects or in the field of competence-based learning and validation of non-formal and informal learning.


